Growth of Political Parties

CAUSE: Differences about Democracy

- Hamilton and his followers fear mob rule.
- Jefferson and his followers fear rule by one person or a few powerful people.

CAUSE: Differences about the Role of the National Government

- Hamilton and his followers want a strong central government.
- Jefferson and his followers prefer a weaker central government.

EFFECT

The Rise of Two Political Parties

CAUSE: Differences over Economic Policy

- Hamilton and his followers promote trade, manufacturing, and the growth of cities.
- Jefferson and his followers support farmers and planters.

CAUSE: Differences over Foreign Policy

- Hamilton and his followers favor the British and oppose the French Revolution.
- Jefferson and his followers favor the French Revolution and fear the British.
